## Modification règlement bio européen concernant l'importation

Un nouveau règlement européen ([2020/2025](#)) est entré en vigueur le 3 février et modifie le règlement bio européen en ce qui concerne le régime d'importation de produits biologiques en provenance des pays tiers, à savoir :

- 🌿 1) à l'article 11, le paragraphe 1 est remplacé par le texte suivant : «1. La Commission examine la possibilité d'inscrire un organisme ou une autorité de contrôle sur la liste prévue à l'article 10 lorsqu'elle reçoit, de la part du représentant de l'organisme ou de l'autorité de contrôle concerné, une demande à cet effet qui soit conforme au modèle fourni par la Commission conformément à l'article 17, paragraphe 2. Seules les demandes complètes soumises au plus tard le 30 juin 2020 seront prises en compte aux fins de la mise à jour de cette liste. » ;
- 🌿 2) à l'article 13, paragraphe 2, le premier alinéa est remplacé par le texte suivant : « **Le certificat d'inspection est délivré par l'autorité ou l'organisme de contrôle compétent avant que le lot ne quitte le pays tiers d'exportation ou d'origine.** Il est approuvé par l'autorité compétente de l'État membre concerné et complété par le premier destinataire sur la base du modèle et des notes figurant à l'annexe V, en utilisant le système informatique vétérinaire intégré (TRACES), institué par la décision 2003/24/CE de la Commission (\*). »
